



## **Conflict of Interest Code for the Silveyville Cemetery District**

The Political Reform act, Government Code Section 81000, et seq., requires state and local government agencies to adopt and promulgate conflict of interest codes. The Fair Political Practices Commission has adopted a regulation, 2 California Code of Regulations, Section 18730, which contains the terms of a standard conflict of interest code. It can be incorporated by reference and may be amended by the Fair Political Practices Commission after public notice and hearings to conform to amendments in the Political Reform Act. Therefore, the terms of 2 California Code of Regulations, Section 18730 and any amendments to it duly adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission are hereby incorporated by reference and, along with the attached Exhibits in which members and employees are designated and disclosure categories are set forth, constitute the conflict of interest code of the agency named above.

Designated employees shall file statement of economic interests with the agency who will make the statements available for public inspection and reproduction. (Government Code Section 81008). Upon receipt of the statements of the agency's board members and chief executive officer, the agency shall make and retain a copy and forward the original of these statements to the Solano County Elections Department, Attention: Statement of Economic Interests filing officer. Statements for all other designated employees will be retained by the agency.

### Exhibit "B"

#### Disclosure Categories:

An investment, interest in real property, or income, is reportable if the business entity in which the investment is held, the interest in real property, or the income or source of income may foreseeably be affected materially by any decision made or participated in by the designated officer by virtue of the officer's position. Financial interests are reportable only if located within the district or subject to the jurisdiction of the district or if the business entity is doing business with the district at any time during the two years prior to the filing of the statement.

Designated officers are members of the board of trustees of the district, the manager and the secretary.

A. Investments in any business entity which within the last two years has contracted to provide or has provided the district with services, supplies, materials, machinery or equipment.

B. Income from any source, provided that the income was furnished by or on behalf of any person or organization which within the last two years has contracted to provide or has provided, or in the future foreseeably may contract to provide or may provide the district with services, supplies, materials, machinery or equipment.

C. His or her interest in undeveloped real property within two miles of the District boundaries.
