COVID-19 POLICY

For the safety of the Silveyville Cemetery District staff and to comply and adhere to the local county and CDC guidelines and restrictions due to the COVID19, we ask for your cooperation in the following ways:

- 1. ANY COVID19 related deaths will be DIRECT BURIAL ONLY. No family or friends will be allowed at graveside but must remain in their vehicles to witness the lowering and leave promptly thereafter.**
- 2. For non-COVID19 related deaths, graveside services will be limited to no more than 45 minutes – from the arrival of the casket to the lowering of the casket. Once the casket is lowered, attendees must leave.**
- 3. No more than 3 households – up to 10 people allowed to attend a burial service.**
- 4. No chairs or public restrooms will be available at this time.**
- 5. All persons are to keep at least a 6-foot distance from other people.**
- 6. All persons are to stay away from cemetery staff at least a 20-foot minimum distance when the casket is being lowered.**
- 7. Do not linger at the cemetery.**
- 8. This policy will be in force until further notice.**

We appreciate your patience and understanding during this time and thank you for helping us do our part in preventing the spread of COVID19.
